

Garwood DAILY Expectations

For Markets, U-Pick, Farmers Markets, and all areas of employment at Garwood's

- Making sure quality produce is displayed is of utmost importance. If it is questionable...throw it away. A review of all produce should be done immediately upon beginning the workday at any market or farmers market.
- Rotate produce to keep the newest product under the older product. DO NOT simply throw new product on top of old. Rotating should also be done immediately upon beginning the workday at any market or farmers market.
- Stores, farmers markets and upick are to have a clean, well kept appearance at all times. Pick up any debris or trash as necessary. Sweep, wipe surfaces, whatever so long as it looks nice.
- When starting for the workday at any area...be sure to have everything you need in stock. Bags, calculators, receipt tape, pens, etc.
- Check and double check any and all price signs to be sure prices are accurate compared to Brian's price sheet and the ad prices.
- Break time is as follows: two- 15 minute breaks during the day and one – 30 minute lunch. BE SURE to write down your lunchtime break as “__minute break” on your timecard or write “no break”, otherwise the standard break-time will be assumed.
- Appearance of markets, upick or farmers market should be the same at the end of each day as it is at the beginning. Especially true at the markets. The only reason an item should not be stocked full on the shelves is if it is totally out in the back. Otherwise all items should be stocked and full for display.
- Bruising produce will not be tolerated. Handle the fruit/vegetables like eggs. This does not mean slowly/methodically...it means carefully. You can work fast and be gentle.
- Smoking is not permitted in any company vehicle, markets or upick stand. Leave the customer area to smoke. Including at farmers markets – no smoking near booth. Period.
- Clean your work area...wherever you are working. Clean any and all trash out of trucks, upick area, farmers market tents, etc.
- **Overall friendliness and a “whatever” it takes type of attitude. Each person here is part of a team. We must all work together to accomplish what needs done. If you need help, ask...if you are not busy in one area...help in another. Whatever needs done, each of us should be willing and able to help in doing it.**
